ITINERARY

Sunday

Meet your coach and travel to your hotel in Charleville Cork, with comfort stops en-route. You will arrive at your hotel late afternoon.

Monday

Today after breakfast you will visit Bunratty Castle and Folk Park. This is your chance to experience a window on Ireland's past and explore the acclaimed 15th century Bunratty Castle and the 19th century Bunratty Folk Park. Enjoy the sights and sounds of this enchanting place as you stroll around this charming village. Later that day you visit Limerick for some free time before returning to your hotel.

Tuesday

Today enjoy a coach trip to Killarney and cruise Killarney's beautiful lakes. This scenic tour offers views of Lough Leane, Killarney's

largest and most picturesque lake. Later that day you will visit Killarney for free time before you re-join your coach and travel back to your hotel.

Wednesday

You have free time to explore Blarney. Why not visit the Blarney Woollen Mills or Blarney Castle (payable locally) and kiss the Blarney Stone. In the afternoon you will travel to the medieval town of Kinsale, often referred to as the gourmet capital of Ireland, with free time to explore a maze of narrow streets, amongst buildings of later periods with historical links to the French, Spanish, British and Americans.

Thursday

You will depart your hotel to make your journey homewards, making stops en-route and returning to your original joining point.
