ITINERARY

Friday

You meet your coach and travel to Belfast to join the early morning ferry crossing to Cairnryan. On arrival travel to Glasgow where you will enjoy a visit to the multi-award winning Riverside Museum home to over 3,000 objects that detail Glasgow's rich past. Later that day you travel onwards to your hotel in Stirling.

Saturday

This morning you visit Edinburgh to enjoy free time at your leisure. Afterwards you will re-join your coach for the short journey to the early evening performance of the Tattoo (Driving time back to the hotel might be longer due to increased traffic).

Please note that day two itinerary is provisional until performance times are confirmed.

Sunday

After a leisurely breakfast and checking out enjoy free time in the medieval city of Stirling, why not visit Stirling Castle, which overlooks the ancient city of Stirling and is one of the historic buildings that have come to symbolise the spirit of Scotland (payable locally). Later in the day you will travel to Cairnryan to join the ferry crossing to Belfast. On arrival, you return to your original joining point.
