ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival in Chicago

Arrive at Chicago O'Hare and transfer independently to your hotel. Meet your ATI tour director at the Welcome Desk between 2 pm and 8 pm. The rest of the day is free for you to relax or explore.

Day 2: Exploring Chicago

Join a morning city tour to see Chicago's iconic architecture and landmarks like the Magnificent Mile and Navy Pier. The afternoon is yours to explore further or book optional excursions.



Day 3: Chicago to St. Louis

Start your Route 66 journey from Chicago to St. Louis. Discover iconic sites and landscapes before reaching St. Louis to explore the Gateway Arch.

Day 4: St. Louis to Springfield

Travel through the Ozark Highlands, stopping at the historic Meramec Caverns. Learn about their fascinating history, including ties to Jesse James.

Day 5: Springfield to Oklahoma City

Journey through Kansas to Oklahoma City, visiting landmarks like the Blue Whale in Catoosa and the historic Route 66 bridge in Tulsa.

Day 6: Oklahoma City to Amarillo

Head to Amarillo, stopping at the Oklahoma Route 66 Museum and iconic Texas attractions like the Conoco Tower Station.



Day 7: Amarillo to Albuquerque

Visit Cadillac Ranch before heading to Albuquerque, a hub for technology and arts, known for its International Balloon Festival.

Day 8: Albuquerque to Holbrook


Explore Gallup and the Navajo Nation, offering a glimpse into Native American culture and history.

Day 9: Holbrook to Page

Travel through Monument Valley, famous for its stunning landscapes and film history. Overnight in Page, AZ.

Day 10: Page to Williams

Visit Antelope Canyon before seeing the Grand Canyon. End the day in Williams with an included train ride through the canyon.



Day 11: Williams to Las Vegas

Travel to Las Vegas via Seligman and Kingman, enjoying an orientation tour of the vibrant city.

Day 12: Discover Las Vegas

Day 13: Las Vegas to Los Angeles

Journey through the Mojave Desert, stopping at Calico Ghost Town before arriving in Los Angeles.
